Chairman, Brazilian Securities and Exchange Commission (CVM)



Marcelo Barbosa is the chairman of the Securities and Exchange Commission of Brazil (CVM), as well as the CVM representative on the IOSCO Board. He has a seat on the Financial Stability Board and on the IFRS Monitoring Board and is a member of the Brazilian Technical Commission of Currency and Credit (COMOC), of the Brazilian Market Regulators Committee (COREMEC), of the Brazilian Council for Private Insurance (CNSP) and of the Brazilian Committee of Financial Education (CONEF).

Mr. Barbosa is an attorney by formation, with relevant experience on corporate law and securities markets, and has acted as arbitrator in numerous arbitral proceedings. Mr. Barbosa served as a professor of Corporate Law at Rio de Janeiro State University and teaches a seminar on Topics of Capital Markets Law at Fundação Getulio Vargas in Rio de Janeiro. He was the chairman of the Board of Trustees of Fundação Estudar and a member of the Columbia Global Centers Latin America Advisory Board and of the Mergers and Acquisitions Committee (CAF). Mr. Barbosa was also a member of the audit committee at Lemann Foundation. He has written several articles on corporate law and securities markets and has participated as a lecturer at conferences in Brazil and abroad. Mr. Barbosa has a bachelor's degree in law from the State University of Rio de Janeiro (UERJ) and an LL.M from Columbia University.
