The Malta Financial Services Authority (“MFSA” or “the Authority”) has become aware of an entity by the name of **CapitaliaFX** which has an internet presence at <https://capitaliaFX.com>. This website is using the details of an MFSA licenced company **ALB Limited**. Fraudsters are using the details and website contents of this genuine company in an effort to deceive the public.

The Authority would like to inform the public that **CapitaliaFX** is **NOT** a Maltese registered company **NOR** is it authorised to provide any financial services in or from Malta. Additionally, **CapitaliaFX** has **NO association** with **ALB Limited**.

The website <https://capitaliaFX.com> therefore appears to be a **clone** of the website of the legitimate entity and the public should therefore refrain from entering into any transactions or otherwise dealing with the false entity on any matters falling within the parameters of the Investment Services Act, Chapter 330 of the Laws of Malta.
