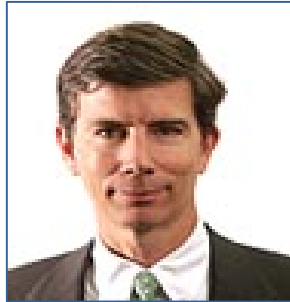


Joseph Tracy



Joseph Tracy is an Executive Vice President and Special Advisor to the President of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. From 2004 to 2009, he was the Director of the Research and Statistics Group at the bank. He is also the Chair of the FSB Data Gap Implementation Group and Chair of the Regulatory Oversight Committee of the LEI. His primary policy focus has been on housing policy. He joined the Bank in 1996 as an officer in the Research and Statistic Group. Prior to joining the New York Fed, Mr. Tracy was an associate professor at Yale University and Columbia University. His academic research focused on labor and urban economics. He holds a BA from University of Missouri and a PhD from the University of Chicago.
