

Lilian Rocca Carbajal Chair – Superintendencia del Mercado de Valores Peru

The Peruvian Securities Market Superintendent is a lawyer from Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú and holds a Master's Degree in International Affairs with a major in Foreign Public Management from the same university. Moreover, she has participated in the Advanced Management Program at the School of Management from Universidad de Piura/IESE Business School, University of Navarra.

Lilian Rocca assumed her duties as Superintendent in August 2011. In May 2014, she was chosen to represent the Inter-American Regional Committee (IARC) in the Board of the International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) and as vice chair of the Council of Securities Regulators of the Americas (COSRA) for the term 2014-2016. In March 2016, Mrs. Rocca was appointed as Vice Chair of IARC for the term 2016-2018. Likewise, she has been appointed as member of the Steering Committee of the Growth and Emerging Market Committee of IOSCO.

Before working in the Superintendence, she worked as Director of the Law School of Universidad San Ignacio de Loyola. She is also professor of Securities Market and Banking Law courses in several Peruvian universities.

Lilian Rocca was considered, by the prestigious British publication Latin Lawyer, as one of the top lawyers of Latin America and one of the most recognized in Peru.

She is the author of a number of publications, including books and articles related to her specialization field.
