On June 9, 2010, the Central Bank of Uruguay became a full signatory to the Multilateral Agreement of Understanding promoted by the International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO); after making the necessary amendments to the Uruguayan securities market legislation and the issuing of regulations by the Superintendency of Financial Services.

It has been for our institution a milestone for the collaboration with other securities regulators for the effective compliance of the legislation within and outside our jurisdiction. Even though the small size of our market, between 2019 and today, we had 54 interchanges of information with 16 different regulators from 4 continents.

It has also facilitated the signing of bilateral agreements and deepened the international relations of our institution. We will continue using this important tool to deepen supervision in a global and digital context world.

We congratulate the IOSCO MMOU team for its twentieth anniversary.
