David Fyfe has 25 years of experience in oil and energy market analysis, covering the spectrum of oil sector activity from upstream, through refining, to demand forecasting. In September 2012 he took on the role of Head of Market Research & Analysis for Gunvor Group Ltd, based in Geneva. At Gunvor, Fyfe is responsible for overseeing research and analysis of oil and energy industry trends and related geopolitical developments, also helping articulate Gunvor's outlook and perspective on commodity trading issues.

Between 2008-2012, David was based in Paris as Editor of the IEA's influential Oil Market Report (OMR), an industry benchmark of trends in oil market fundamentals and pricing. Prior to that, from 2002 to mid-2008, David was responsible for the IEA's regular OPEC and non-OPEC upstream oil supply analysis and projections published in the monthly Oil Market Report (OMR) and in the Medium-Term Oil Market Report (MTOMR).

David holds a BSc in geological sciences, and a Masters in Energy Policy and Economics from Imperial College, University of London. His career began with a consortium of North Sea oil sector service providers. He joined Petroleum Economics Ltd. in London in 1985, providing analysis of long-term energy trends, including non-OPEC oil supply, global demand prospects and developing-country gas and electricity developments. In 1990 he left PEL and helped set up Energy Market Consultants Ltd (EMC). In 1997 he was made Director for Downstream Market Analysis at EMC. David left EMC in 2002 to join the IEA in Paris. He is a regular contributor to government, oil industry, media and financial sector oil market forums.
