La Semaine mondiale de l'investisseur de l'OICV se concentrera sur les th mes de la r silience des investisseurs, les risques associ s aux cryptoactifs et la finance durable.

L'Organisation internationale des commissions de valeurs (OICV) c l brera la septi me  dition de la Semaine mondiale de l'investisseur (IOSCO World Investor Week / IOSCO-WIW), du 2 au 8 octobre 2023. Toutefois, les juridictions participantes pourront tenir leurs activit s plus tard en octobre ou novembre.

Comme en t moigne le rapport [IOSCO WIW 2022 Public Report](#), publi  aujourd'hui, le nombre de juridictions participant   la WIW ne cesse d'augmenter, tant dans les march s d velopp s que les march s  mergents. Par cons quent, malgr  les conditions difficiles rencontr es pendant la pand mie, le nombre de juridictions et de partenaires/supporteurs de la IOSCO WIW a augment  successivement au cours des campagnes 2020, 2021 et 2022, confirmant l'importance de l' ducation financi re comme moyen de renforcer la protection des investisseurs.

Compte tenu des conditions actuelles et des pr visions  conomiques mondiales, le conseil d'administration de l'OICV a identifi  trois th matiques pertinentes pour l'**IOSCO WIW 2023** : la *r silience des investisseurs*, les *risques associ s aux cryptoactifs* et la *finance durable*. D'autres th mes couvrant la *pr vention de la fraude*, les *notions de base en investissement* et la *finance digitale* sont  galement au programme.

M. Jean-Paul Servais, pr sident du conseil d'administration de l'OICV et pr sident de l'Autorit  des services et march s financiers, Belgique, a d clar  : « La protection des investisseurs est un objectif cl  de l'OICV. Les autorit s r glementaires en valeurs mobili res utilisent diff rents outils pour promouvoir et am liorer la protection des investisseurs, y compris la r glementation, la supervision, la surveillance et l' ducation financi re. Pendant la pand mie, les investisseurs ont  t  confront s   de nouveaux et s rieux risques ; certains de ces risques peuvent perdurer ou m me  voluer. En r ponse   ces enjeux, le Plan d'action 2023-2024 de l'OICV continuera de soutenir l' ducation des investisseurs en tant que pilier essentiel de la protection des investisseurs, ainsi que d'autres mesures visant   lutter contre les comportements r pr hensibles et la fraude sur les march s financiers,   promouvoir des initiatives visant   favoriser la confiance des investisseurs et l'inclusion financi re, ainsi qu'  prot ger les int r ts des investisseurs. »

NOTES TO THE EDITORS:

1. IOSCO is the leading international policy forum for securities regulators and is recognized as the global standard setter for securities regulation. The organization's membership regulates more than 95% of the world's securities markets in some 130 jurisdictions, and it continues to expand.
2. The IOSCO Board is the governing and standard-setting body of IOSCO and is made up of 35 securities regulators. Mr. Jean-Paul Servais, the Chair of Belgium's Financial Services and Markets Authority (FSMA) is the Chair of the IOSCO Board. The members of the IOSCO Board are the securities regulatory authorities of Australia, Bahamas, Bangladesh, Belgium, Brazil, China, Egypt, France, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, India, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Korea, Kuwait, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, Morocco, the Netherlands, Oman, Ontario, Peru, Quebec, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Türkiye, the United Kingdom and the United States of America (both the U.S. Commodity Futures Trading Commission and U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission). The Chair of the European Securities and Markets Authority and the Chair of IOSCO's Affiliate Members Consultative Committee are also observers.
3. The Growth and Emerging Markets (GEM) Committee is the largest committee within IOSCO, representing more than 75% per cent of the IOSCO membership, including 10 of the G20 members. Dr Mohamed Farid Saleh, Executive Chairman of the Financial Regulatory Authority, Egypt is Chair of the GEM Committee. The committee brings members from growth and emerging markets together and communicates members' views and facilitates their contribution across IOSCO and at other global regulatory discussions. The GEM Committee's strategic priorities are focused, amongst others, on risks and vulnerabilities assessments, policy and development work affecting emerging markets, and regulatory capacity building.
4. IOSCO aims through its permanent structures:
 - to cooperate in developing, implementing and promoting internationally recognized and consistent standards of regulation, oversight and enforcement to protect investors, maintain fair, efficient and transparent markets, and seek to address systemic risks;
 - to enhance investor protection and promote investor confidence in the integrity of securities markets, through strengthened information exchange and cooperation in enforcement against misconduct and in supervision of markets and market intermediaries; and
 - to exchange information at both global and regional levels on their respective experiences to assist the development of markets, strengthen market infrastructure and implement appropriate regulation.
